Recent community outreach suggest the number of homeless individuals within the city number approximately 100, with an additional 60 finding shelter in facilities such as La Posada. She was joined by Marie Jones-Kirk from the City of Carlsbad and Sergeant Christie Calderwood from CPD that discussed a task force that was in place at CPD to aid with the growing problem and to connect these individuals with the resources that they may need.
