James A. Speer, now serving his first year of a two-year term as a director of Rotary International, began his Rotary involvement in 1951, at the age of 21. His interest in civic, vocational, and Rotary affairs spans a wide variety of commitments.

Jim was president of the Rotary Club of Baldwin Park, Calif., in 1957-58, and in 1962-63 served Rotary International as governor of District 530. The high point in his Rotary Commitment was his selection to serve on the 1979-80, 1980-81 Rotary International Board of Directors, which is comprised of 17 members from 11 countries.

He has spoken before conventions of R. I., and on numerous occasions has been selected by R. I. presidents to be their personal representative at district conferences throughout the United States. Twice he was selected to be a leader to help train incoming district governors at Rotary's International Assembly.

Jean and Jim Speer reside in Glendora; they are the owners of three flower shops in Covina and Glendora. He is a

member of the Rotary Club of Covina, a past-president of the Covina Chamber of Commerce, and a past-president of the Southern California and California State Florists' associations. He is also a past-district representative and national committeeman of the Florists' Transworld Delivery Association.
