

Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club Vocational Scholarship Application

For students pursuing a vocation not requiring a BA or BS Degree (Examples: Computer Technician, Mechanic, Welder, Construction, Entertainer, Cosmetologist, Lab Technician, Medical Assistant etc.)

Applicants for Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club (CHNR) Scholarships must be high school seniors or current academic year graduates who plan to enroll in the next available semester for full-time undergraduate study at an accredited vocational college, trade or technical school for the upcoming academic year. Students must be residents of the City of Carlsbad, or non-residents attending a high school located in the Carlsbad city limits. Students whose parents or grandparents are active Rotarians are ineligible.

All applications are reviewed by CHNR committee members for interviews. Not all applicants may be interviewed. Not all applicants interviewed will necessarily be awarded scholarships. All interviews are required and will be conducted by the committee at the Carlsbad High School Counseling Department at a date and time to be determined by the Scholarship Committee. Selection of award recipients is made by the Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Scholarship Committee.

A completed application packet includes the application form, current transcripts, three letters of recommendation (no more than two by faculty). Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. Refer to the Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club Scholarship Program Policy on the club website (carlsbadhinoonrotary.org) or Scholarship Committee if you have questions.

THE PROGRAM

Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club (CHNR) has an established scholarship program to assist graduating Carlsbad high school students, or residents of Carlsbad who attend high schools outside of Carlsbad Unified School District. Scholarships are offered each year for full-time study at an accredited institution of the student's choice.

The scholarship program is administered by the Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club Scholarship Committee. The Committee Chair and members are appointed each year by the Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club Youth Services Director, an elected board position. Carlsbad High School college/university scholarship applications are administered by Carlsbad High School Counselor's Department. Applicants attending other qualified schools are administered by the Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club Scholarship Committee. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, gender, disability or national origin.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants for the Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club scholarships must be high school seniors or current academic year graduates who plan to enroll in the next available semester for full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school for the entire upcoming academic year. Students must be residents of the City of Carlsbad, or non-residents of the city attending a high school located in the Carlsbad city limits. Students with parents or grandparents who are or have been active Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary members within the past three years are ineligible.

AWARDS

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive an award as determined by the Scholarship Committee.

- **High School Scholarships**, **Including Vocational Scholarships**: The number and amount of each year's scholarship awards are based on the fundraising success of the club.
- AVID scholarships: The number of awards granted each year is determined by the amount of
 funds designated by the Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club Foundation. Amounts may vary based
 upon the number of applications received. Students awarded AVID scholarships are also eligible
 for the regular high school/vocational scholarships as determined by the Scholarship Committee.
- · Awards are for undergraduate study only.

APPLICATION

Interested students must complete the application available through the Carlsbad High School Counselor's Department or through the Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary website (carlsbadhinoonrotarty.org) or its members. Applications, together with the transcript of grades and three letters of recommendation (not more than two from teachers/staff of their school), are to be provided by the student's High School Counselor's Department directly to the Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club Scholarship Committee no later than the Wednesday prior to April 1. Submission deadline for completed applications is Thursday, March 27th, 2025 at 3 PM. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information provided; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by the Scholarship Committee.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients are selected based on academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals and aspirations, unusual personal or family circumstances, and an outside appraisal. Financial need is not considered.



All applications are reviewed by scholarship committee members for interviews. Not all applicants may be interviewed. Not all applicants interviewed will necessarily be awarded scholarships. All interviews will be conducted at the Carlsbad High School Counselor's Department at a date and time to be determined by the Scholarship Committee. Selection of recipients is made by the Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Scholarship Committee. All applicants agree to accept the decision as final. CHS applicants will be notified at the annual scholarship awards ceremony held at Carlsbad High School. Other qualifying applicants will be notified at a date, time and location as determined by the Scholarship Committee.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

The Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club Foundation processes and distributes all scholarship payments. All payments will be sent directly to the recipient's school's Financial Aid Department where enrollment is verified. Students are required to provide enrollment verification and contact information regarding the school's Financial Aid Department. Proceeds may be used for any purposes related directly to educational expenses as determined by the school's Financial Aid Department, which may include, but are not necessarily limited to, tuition, books and materials, equipment and software required for course work, and housing. Scholarship awards must be claimed by the student or student's Financial Aid Department by March 15 of the calendar year following the award. Scholarship funds not claimed by March 15 will be forfeited. If all funds are not used in the first academic year of enrollment, any remaining funds are to be returned to the Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club Foundation.

OBLIGATIONS

Recipients have an obligation to Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club to return any unused funds. Additionally, they are required to notify CHNR of any changes in school enrollment or other relevant information.

REVISIONS

Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.
