Megan Dekorne from White Labs presented a fascinating talk on the use of hi-tech yeasts in the beer and wine industries. White Labs Inc. was founded in 1995 and supplies breweries, wineries and distilleries with fresh yeast and related products. White Labs was the innovator of pitchable yeast. This living yeast imparts a better flavor to the finished product. Their scientists also trouble shoot breweries and wineries that are having problems with their fermentation process. The biotech has offices in San Diego, Davis, and Boulder. Immediate Past President Steve Nuñez, is arranging an Old Mission Rotary tour of their tasting room in Miramar where they brew small batches of their own beers!
