We have all heard of seeing eye dogs but what if a person needs a pair of ears? On June 17, the Art Pratt Foundation of Old Mission Rotary presented a grant of \$2000 to K-9 Friendly Visitors. This non profit provides service dogs to the deaf, hard of hearing, disabled and to people with special needs. The Art Pratt Grant focuses on dogs that serve as ears for deaf masters. The dogs alert their masters when the door bell rings, an alarm clock goes off, the telephone rings and even when the tea kettle whistles! Collies are used exclusively for the program because of their natural ability to herd people away from danger.

1000 Smiles

The 1,000 Smiles Foundation is a non-profit organization focused on care of the less fortunate children in Mexico who suffer from lack of dental care and from maxillo-facial deformities such as cleft palate. The organization was created in 1985 by members of the National City and Chula Vista Rotary Clubs and is now supported by two Rotary Districts. Our speaker, Kim Muslusky discovered 1000 Smiles 21 years ago when assigned the duties of International Service Chair as the first woman member of the San Diego North Rotary club. Since then, Kim has served as president and is now the secretary of 1000 Smiles. Clinics take place every three months at the 1000 Smiles facility in Ensenada. Cleft palate surgeries are performed in nearby hospitals but 1000 Smiles has raised \$60,000 toward building and equipping a permanent surgical suite. Dental services such as teeth cleaning, crowns and cavity repaired are also provided. Old Mission Rotary is a huge supporter of 1000 Smiles and Stan Vogelsang announced that our So You Think You've Got Talent San Diego gala raised \$20,000 for the organization.
