Water, Water Everywhere

Teresa Penunuri delivered the message that after three straight dry winters and record-breaking heat in the first half of 2014, California's water supply situation is becoming more serious each day. Water is a precious resource that we take for granted. Our Mediterranean climate is wonderful but yields an average of only 9.9 inches of rain per year. The 2012 and 2013 rainfall totals were significantly below average. Our traditional supplies of water are the Bay Delta (20%) and the Colorado River (63%). Water recycling accounts for another 17% of our water supply. A new source of water is from improved conservation technology in the Imperial Valley where new canal linings are saving water. The Water Authority expects to add desalinated seawater



with the completion of the Carlsbad Desalination Project in early 2016. Production of groundwater aquifers is also on the horizon. The question of water rationing is directly related to the weather. A wet winter could recharge snowpack levels and reservoirs and help the San Diego region avoid water supply cutbacks. Teresa drove home the point that residents and businesses have the power to help the region manage its supplies by conserving more water now.
