

The Medical Minute

by Dr. Kevin Glynn Last week's JAMA contains an update on the seriousness of the Ebola virus outbreak now spreading in western Africa. Infection usually occurs by direct contact, e. g. eating infected meat, touching an infected person, or handling infected body fluids. Two Americans infected with Ebola have received an experimental anti-serum, which has triggered discussions about the shortage of such treatment in the places where the infection is most prevalent. The World Health Organization has declared Ebola a global health emergency and recommends against travel to the area. Anyone returning to the U.S. from West Africa may be placed in quarantine on arrival, since exposed individuals can manifest the disease as long as 21 days after being infected.

539 cases of measles have been reported in the U. S. this year, the highest number since 1994. Most cases have occurred in individuals returning from travel abroad. Outbreaks have clustered in areas where unvaccinated children reside. Maintaining high immunization levels is a critical part of preventing large outbreaks.
