#### Shelter Box 23311



Pete Griffith is a member of the Golden Triangle Rotary Club and serves as a District 5340 champion of the Rotary Shelter Box Program.

On Tuesday, August 19, Tim Mc-Cully and Pete Griffith presented a program on Shelter Boxes. The Shelter Box project was conceived and developed by a Rotarian in England in 2001. The mission is to deliver immediate relief to victims of natural and other disasters anywhere around the world. As of January 2007, shelter boxes have been sent to 31 different countries providing shelter for nearly 500,000 people.

A Shelter Box typically includes a disaster relief tent for a family of ten people, thermal blankets, groundsheets, water storage and purification equipment, solar lamps, cooking utensils, a basic tool kit, mosquito nets and children's activity pack.

Old Mission Rotary already has one Shelter Box 23311 that is

standing by to be deployed. Our club's Project Committee has committed to a new Shelter Box for this year and club members have responded to the challenge with pledges. The cost of a Shelter Box is \$1000 USD.
