Thank you to International Service Chair. Bob James, who has written and submitted a Distrct Grant request for \$3000 to support our painting project at the Salvador **Diaz Miron School at Colonia** Lomas de San Ramon in San Quentin Baja. The grant is officially referred to as Project P-644 and has been published on the District 5340 Matching Grants website. Old Mission Rotarians will be travelling to to San Quentin over the weekend of 22-25 August (Friday to Monday). We will be working with other groups from the VIIDAI program to paint the exterior and interior of the school. Bob joked that we will not be using the standard soft gringo colors but will be applying vibrant colors selected by the Mexican Colonia school staff!

Rebuilding Together San Diego

Rebuilding Together San Diego was established in 1995. Their mission is to bring together volunteers and the community to improve the homes and lives of lowincome homeowners who are in need. They help revitalize neighborhoods throughout San Diego. Since then, they have rehabilitated over 400 homes and facilities serving thousands of local residents. This work would not be possible without the help from hundreds of volunteers, civic-minded companies, building tradesmen, and community groups who participate with sponsorships, financial contributions, and in-kind donations of resources, materials, and time. Tyler Silva organized Old Mission Rotary's participation in a Rebuilding San Diego Project back in April for Rotarians at Work Day. The one day project dramatically transformed the Point Loma home of a disabled Coast Guard veteran. Old Mission Rotarians cleaned up debris and hauled wood chips into the yard. Other teams painted and professional landscapers and electricians donated materials and expertise.
