The Medical Minute



Dr. Kevin Glynn reported on the treatment of elevated serum cholesterol in the elderly. The issue is complicated because studies of therapy for elevated blood lipids have not included subjects over the age of 75. Since their lifespans are shorter, it is more difficult to demonstrate benefit from cholesterol lowering drugs like statins in the elderly. In addition there is no evidence to support starting drugs to lower cholesterol in patients older than 75 who have no signs of cardiovascular disease. Plus, the elderly are more subject to side effects, and because they often take several medications, are more at risk for unexpected drug reactions than are younger patients. Therefore when starting statins and other drugs in elderly patients, physicians should prescribe low to moderate doses, e. g. atorvastatin (Lipitor) 10-20 mgm. daily.
