LEAD Students from Francis Parker

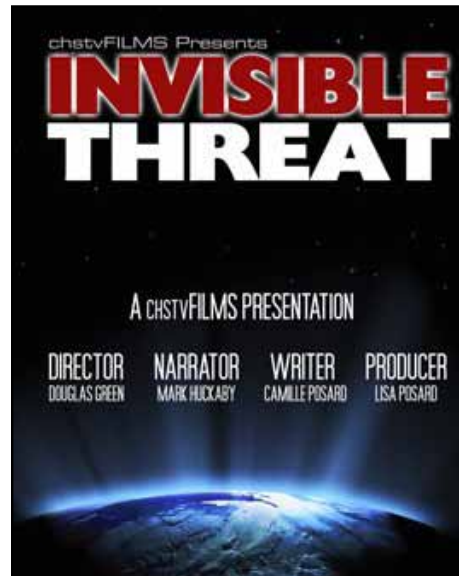

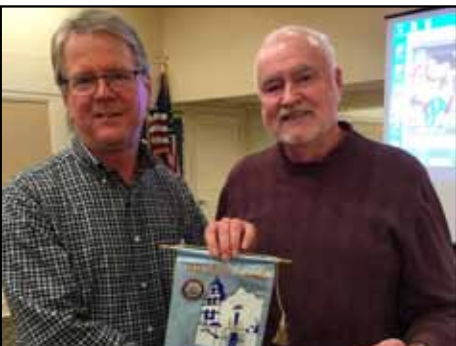
One easy way to support Project Peanut Butter is to designate contributions to the RI Foundation for this specific program.
