The Rotary Children's Fund



Vitaliy Bedroznov is a professional musician and the founder of the Rotary Children's Fund. He has been a Rotarian since 1995.

The RCF (Rotary Children's Fund) was founded in 2003 by Vitaliy Bedroznov and exists to promote good will between countries by funding groups of youth that contribute to peace, cultural understanding and appreciation through the arts.

The organization finds young artists, performers and musicians worldwide to share their cultures through their performances and workshops where they feature their talents, traditional costumes and individual personalities.

The Golden Gates Cultural Youth Program was set up in 2003 to administer the travel of the student groups. One group recently performed at the Escondido Center for the Arts.

The founder of the Rotary Children's Fund, Vitaliy Bedroznov was born in Tashkent in the former Soviet Union. His musical talents

took him on tour in the USA as the accordionist of the group *Moscow Nights*. He attended a meeting of the Denver Rotary Club in 1995 and was so impressed that he knew at once he needed to become a Rotarian.

The RCF is inspired by Rotarians, funded by Rotarians and run by Rotarians! Vitaliy's presentation showed how the program relates directly to the Rotary Four Way Test
