



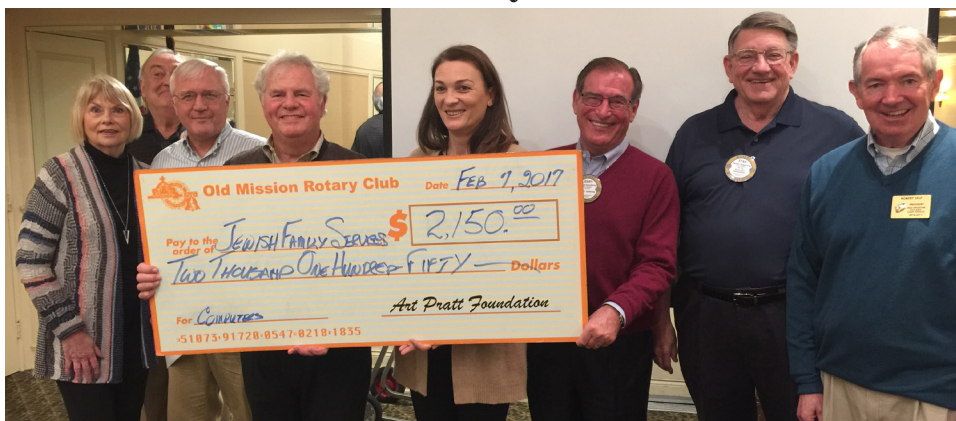

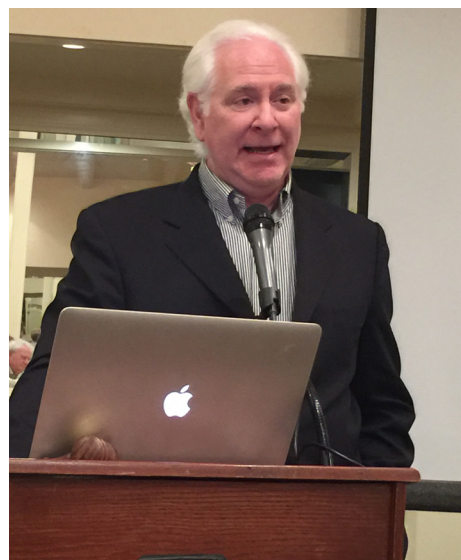
## President Elect Training Seminar- PETS

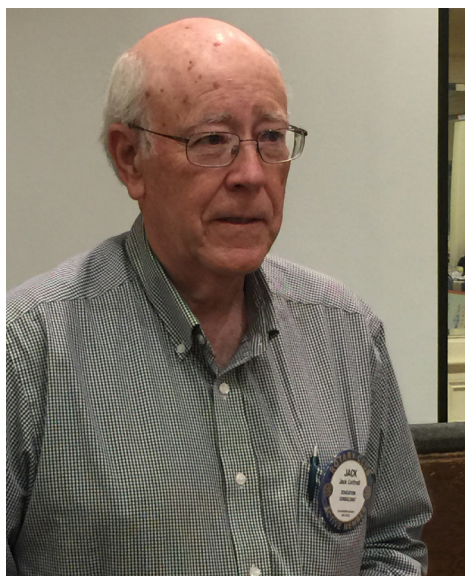
Jeffrey Seay is a retired NCIS Special Agent. The NCIS mission is to investigate and defeat criminal, terrorist, and foreign intelligence threats to the United States Navy and Marine Corps—ashore, afloat, and in cyberspace.

He spent more than half his career in the Far East in counterintelligence, counter-terrorism and force protection operations. He has the distinction of being the first Personal Security Adviser to the Commander of the Seventh Fleet. He also completed a decorated tour
