Rotarians are proud to promote high ethical standards in their professional lives. The Four-Way Test was created in 1932 by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor when he was asked to take charge of a company that was facing bankruptcy. This 24-word test was adopted by Rotary in 1943.

Eric Benink once again served as chairman and organized an amazing event. Our club judges were Judy Copeland, Michele Tondreau and Larry Edwards.

On February 21st, four high school students from the Reality Changers Program participated in the Old Mission Rotary Four Way Test Speech Program. They each delivered amazing talks on ethics and our club judges were hard pressed to select a winner.

Abraham Mendez won the event with a talk on the "Food Desert of City Heights." He used the four Way Test to point out the injustice and irony of the lack of nutritious food in the struggling immigrant community where he lives. Abraham will go on to participate in the next level of the Rotary District 5340 contest.

Jordan Harrison represented Reality Changers. The program gives students an opportunity to become the first in their families to attend college and provides a positive culture in inner city neighborhoods.
