Art Pratt Foundation of Old Mission Rotary Grant to San Diego Museum of Art

The San Diego Museum of Art has graced the Plaza de Panama in Balboa Park for almost a century. Their mission is to inspire, educate, and cultivate curiosity through great works of art. Their permanent collection includes over 22,000 works of art from across the globe, spanning 3,000 BC to the present day. The museum origins can be traced to the 1915-1916 Panama-California International Exposition and the museum officially opened on February 28, 1926 and was known as The Fine Arts Gallery of San Diego until 1978. During WWII the museum was used by the Navy as was most of Balboa Park. The distinctive museum façade, restored in 2008, includes life-sized sculptures of Spanish Old Master painters Velázquez, Murillo, and Zurbarán. The San Diego Museum of Art welcomed 395,000 visitors last year who hailed from all 50 states and 65 countries. The museum served over 4,000 students through workshops and other educational programming

Thousand Smiles Winter Clinic

Members of Old Mission Rotary travelled to Ensenada over the fiirst weekend in February to participate in the Thousand Smiles Winter Clinic.

Thousand Smiles is composed of doctors, dentists, orthodontists, speech therapists, audiologists, health educators, nurses, and regular volunteers who work to provide dental care, orthodontia, as well as surgical repair of cleft lips/cleft palates for children in Mexico who might otherwise receive no care. Clinics take place quarterly and over a Friday and Saturday. During the February Clinic as many as 150 children received dental services and thirteen children had surgeries in the new on site surgical suites.
