Art Pratt Grant to Fight Sexual Violence



Center for Community Solutions

The Art Pratt Foundation of Old Mission Rotary presented a grant of \$1726 to the Center for Community Solutions. The funds will be used to improve a playground at an emergency shelter for battered women. Founded in 1969, Center for Community Solutions (CCS) helps more than 10,000 adults and children each year to heal and prevent relationship and sexual violence. CCS operates the only rape crisis center in the city of San Diego along with a countywide 24-hour bilingual crisis helpline. The nonprofit agency also provides emergency domestic violence shelters, hospital and court accompaniment, as well as legal and counseling services for those affected by domestic violence and sexual assault.
