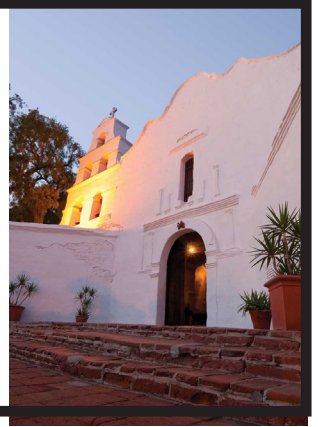

### Honored by Viidai

Viidai (Viajes Interinstitucional de Integracion Docente, Asistencial y de Investigacion) is a unique, international public health field program in Baja Mexico. Old Mission Rotary and specifically Bob James, Stan Vogelsang and Jerry Hosenkamp have been an integral part of Viidai.

On Saturday, April 16th, Dr. Stephanie Brodeans of SDSU hosted a party at her Point Loma home to thank key members of the Viidai team including staff from the medical schools in Tijuana and UCSD and the SDSU School of Public Health. Bob James Sr. was honored for over 20 years of participation in the project. Bob was the initial driving force for our club's participation over 20 years ago.

Projects funded for the Salvador Diaz Miron School for Viidai by Old Mission Rotary include:

- A kitchen at the school
- A library
- A computer center with 15 PCs
- Electrical and Plumbing improvements
