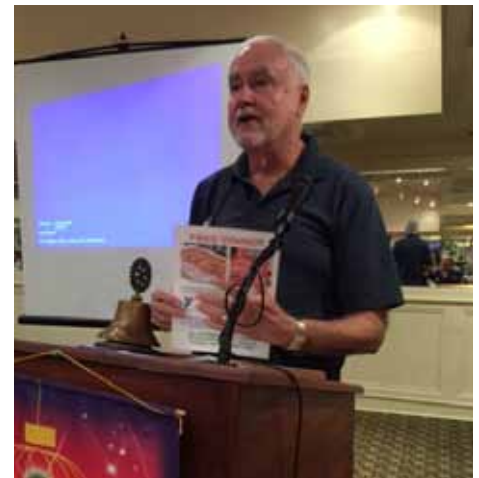

Vision Therapy

Some visual conditions cannot be treated adequately with just glasses, contact lenses or patching, and are best resolved through a program of Vision Therapy. Vision Therapy is an individualized, supervised, treatment program designed to correct visual-motor and/or perceptual-cognitive deficiencies. Vision Therapy sessions include procedures designed to enhance the brain's ability to control: eye alignment, tracking focusing and visual processing. Visual-motor skills and endurance are developed through the use of specialized computer and optical devices, including therapeutic lenses, prisms, and filters.

Children and adults with visual challenges such as Learning-related Vision Problems can benefit from Vision Therapy which can help those individuals who lack the necessary visual skills for effective reading, writing, and learning.
