#### **Model UN**




Lydia Stewart is the champion of our Model UN program at Old Mission Rotary!

The stock market is recovering from set backs in December and the economy looks strong. Interest rates are stable and unemployment is very low. The cloud on the horizon is the inverted yield curve that traditionally precedes a recession. An inverted yield-curve occurs when long-term debts have a lower yield as compared with short-term debt.
