Thousand Smiles Weekend




Lydia Stewart reported on the great success of the Thousand Smiles Clinic in Ensenada over the weekend of May 2-4.



The Medical Minute

Dr. Kevin Glynn updated the club on the documentary "The Invisible Threat." Students at Carlsbad High School made the film with help from a Rotary grant. The documentary looks at the controversy swirling around vaccines and vaccination programs. Today, many Americans believe that vaccinations are either unnecessary or dangerous. Some claim that vaccinations can even lead to autism in children. In the course of making the film, the students came to the conclusion that the choice not to have one's child vaccinated is a choice to put one's child at unnecessary risk. The science behind the issue is clear and Rotary has seen the miracle of vaccination programs across the globe.
