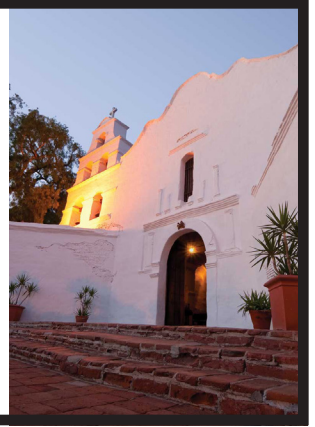

Honoring USA Heroes, established in 2020, is working to ensure that we never forget our firefighters, law enforcement officers and military soldiers who have paid the ultimate price to protect and save the lives of others. Donna Maytum and Miles Durfee Nominated for Art Pratt Foundation

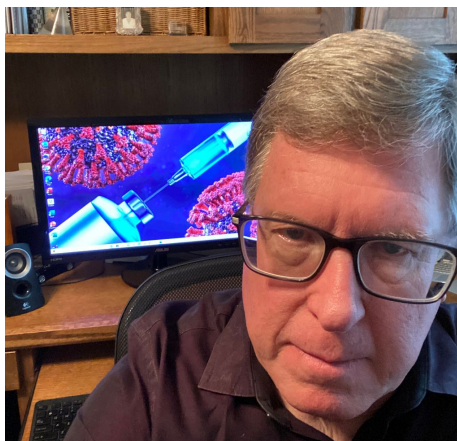
