



VIIDAI

VIIDAI is a unique, international public health field experience in Baja Mexico. This is an acronym for V (viajes/travels), I (inter-institutional), I (integracion), D (docente/teaching), A (asistencia), I (investigaciones). VIIDAI is in its 6th year and is a partnership between three academic institutions: the SDSU GSPH, Universidad Autónoma de Baja California, Tijuana, School of Medicine and the UCSD School of Medicine. Stan Vogelsang, Bob James and Niles Sharif all participated in the May VIIDAI weekend in San Quentin Baja. Old Mission has contributed to a computer center and a library for the migrant worker camp.
