Taxes...Taxes... Everywhere



Eric Benink is a dedicated Rotarian and Past President of Old Mission Rotary. He is a partner at Krause Kalfayan Benink & Slavens, LLP. In November 1996, California voters passed Proposition 218, the "Right to Vote on Taxes Act". This constitutional amendment protects taxpayers by limiting the methods by which local governments can create or increase taxes, fees and charges without taxpayer consent.

Eric's firm represents citizens and taxpayer groups who seek to challenge taxes disguised as government fees, charges and assessments.

Eric discussed a recent case where his firm represented a resident ratepayer against the City of Chino alleging that it violated California Constitution article XIII D (Proposition 218) by transferring funds each year from its water utility fund to its general fund as a transfer in lieu of property taxes. Petitioner alleged that the transfers violated Proposition 218 because they were not tied to the actual cost of providing water service to Chino Residents. The verdict returned over \$4 million from the general fund to the water utility fund,
