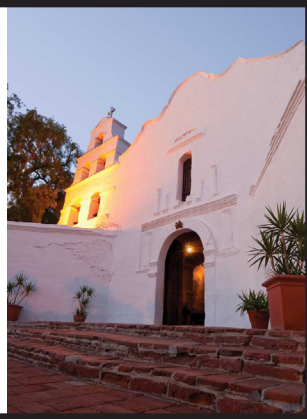

Wounded Warriors in our Hearts

Old Mission Rotary has been hosting Wounded Warrior Dinners on the last Thursday of every month for the past five years at the San Diego Naval Medical Center. During the height of the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan we met many seriously wounded Marines and Sailors. Old Mission has maintained contact with Wounded Warriors who are out of the service but living locally. Two of our Wounded Warriors regularly attend Old Mission Rotary events and are part of our Rotary family.

Isaac Blount lost both legs, part of his left hand and his left eye to an IED ambush. Isaac was featured on 60 Minutes when he climbed the highest mountain in Australia, Mount Kosciuszko, with the Heroes Project.

Chris Van Etten lost his legs in an IED attack. Today, he is a model for the Jockey "Show 'em What's Underneath" campaign and has been featured in People Magazine and on television.

Sadly, one of our wounded warriors, Artem Luzukin, could not adjust to post war life and took his own life.

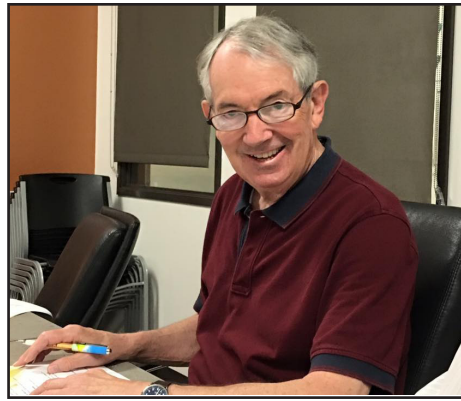

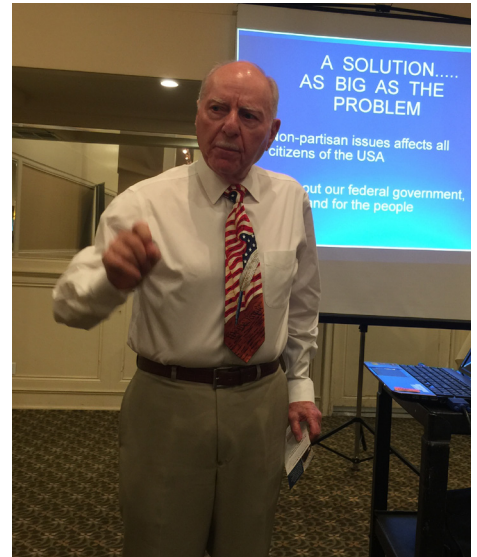

Convention of States



Political activist, Ron Obermen, promoted the Convention of States as a way to end run around the US Congress and change the Constitution of the United States.

Article V of the US Constitution allows states to convene a Convention of States. Activists who wish to curb the power of the Federal Government see this as a way to amend the Constitution without the participation of Congress. The convention would be established and run by state legislators. Our speaker explained that reasons to change the Constitution with this unprecedented tactic was to curb the power of the Federal Government and return power to the individual states.
