One magical Rotary moment was when Dan became involved with a prosthetics office in Baja. Dan worked with a team that built a workshop where artificial limbs could be built and assembled. He was overwhelmed when he witnessed the joy of a young boy named Victor who received a pair of legs to replace those lost in a car accident.

At the RI Convention in Copenhagen, Dan was awed by a key note address from an Irish nun who founded the Missionvale Care Centre in the extremely poor township of Missionvale in Port Elizabeth, South Africa. Dan was mesmerized by Sister Ethel Normoyle and her spirit of service. Dan not only met with Sister Ethel but made several trips to the center and helped arrange a series of 30 Rotary Grants totaling \$685,000. Dan also participated in a program to provide shoes that ultimately gave away some 350,000 pairs of footwear. Dan is always asking himself "Who gets to do such amazing service projects...Rotarians do!"
