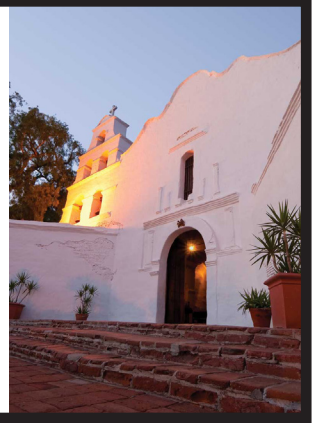

I Love a Clean San Diego was first founded as the *San Diego War Against Litter Committee* in 1954 and has evolved over the 67 years to improve the health and beauty of San Diego.

Their programs provide a tremendous education on the huge scale and challenges of handling waste in our city.

The average person in San Diego creates 6.1 pounds per day and our Miramar Landfill will be full by 2030! The good news is that 75% of our trash can be recycled.

Organic waste makes up 39% of our solid waste and new green barrels will collect our household food waste.

The biggest issue is plastic and our speaker urged us to stop buying items in plastic packaging as much as possible.
