Tom Basham is a long time member of Old Mission Rotary.

Our very own Tom Basham talked to the club about the National Cemetery Administration and the essential role it plays to provide the perpetual care for our honored veterans who have been laid to rest. The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs is keeping it promises to 3.8 million American Veterans, Reservists and family members so that their contributions to the nation will always be remembered.

Tom served as the Director of Design and Construction for all of the National Cemeteries. He described his work across the country but focused primarily of the new Miramar National Cemetery that was dedicated on 30 January 2010. The cemetery is beautifully landscape and the tranquility is only interrupted by the roar of fighter jets from the adjacent Marine Corps Air Station can accommodate the remains of approximately 235,000 veterans and spouses.

Stan Vogelsang invited VIDAII founder Dr. Stephanie Brodine to lunch at Old Mission Rotary. VIDAII is a bi-national collaboration between the Universidad Autónoma de Baja California (UABC) medical school, San Diego State University (SDSU) and the University of California San Diego (UCSD) medical school. VIIDAI's mission is to create an opportunity for students and faculty from these three universities to work together to provide medical services and public health education to colonias in Baja California, Mexico, Dr. Stephanie Brodine, MD was one of the founders of this public health effort back in 1998. She was a retired Navy Captain and was starting a second career on the faculty of San Diego State University. Old Mission Rotarian Bob James Sr. introduced our club to VID-AII in 2007. Club members Stan Vogelsang, Jerry Hosenkamp and Mark McAnelly have been very active participants in the program. Since then, Old Mission Rotary has worked with the school at the colonia to fund the projects that they asked for. These included a computer center, library, shade structure, electrical and lighting improvements, a new classroom, soccer uniforms and equipment and exterior painting of the school. We also participated in a recycled water system that provides fresh water to the students.

VIDAII will ramp up again for our twice a year visits post Covid-19.
