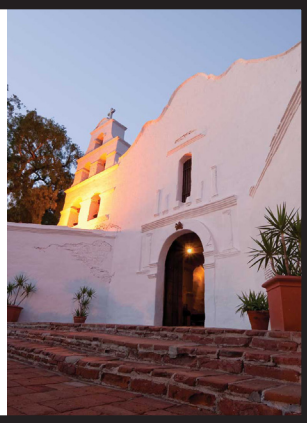

Host Gil Kleecan



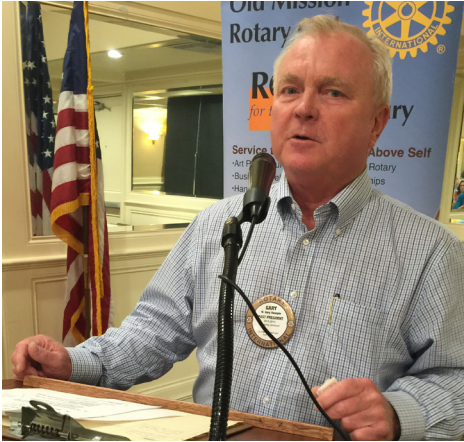
Our host on August 11th was Gil Kleecan.
