Corona Conversation





Community Service

Charlotte Cofield serves as our Community Service Chair and has been instrumental with partnering with STAR/PAL on a service project to distribute back packs filled with school supplies to inner city youth in Colina Park and in Encanto. STAR/PAL was founded in 1988 and is a San Diego-based nonprofit organization with a unique nationally recognized model of police and community collaboration. Sworn officers from the San Diego Police and County Probation Departments work side-by-side with civilian personnel and trained law enforcement volunteers to provide the leadership and mentoring critical in promoting youth safety, positive life choices, and academic success. All STAR/PAL programs are led by law enforcement officers who educate youth about the dangers of juvenile crime and violence.

Cultivating Literacy

Our ZOOM Club program on August 18th was presented by Julia Neff and Leigh Monistere of Cultivating Literacy. Their mission is to empower families of early readers by providing strategies, individualized interventions, and expert guidance to help children grow as successful readers and writers.

Their program is designed for kindergarten through first-grade children in the Santa Clara, CA community who need more practice and attention in reading and writing instruction.

Intervening early in a child's education can help address areas of need early on as opposed to later when these needs may have further developed. Their specialists work with kindergarten through firstgrade students who show signs of foundational literacy needs.

Brian Dempsey presented a Who Am I on August 18th. Brian grew up on the Jersey Shore in a large Irish-Catholic family. He attended college at the Jesuit, Roman Catholic St. Peter's University in Jersey City. After school he decided to join the Navy and was commissioned as a Naval Flight Officer. The Vietnam War was winding down but Operation Linebacker sent his ship, the aircraft carrier USS Saratoga, from a scheduled Mediterranean assignment to the South China Sea. Brian flew combat missions against North Vietnam until the North Vietnamese agreed to return to the peace table in Paris. Brian enjoyed his career in the Navy that along with flying off aircraft carriers included a NATO posting in Oslo Norway and shore duty in Gaeta Italy. Brian was wrapping up his military service as an NROTC instructor at the University of Illinois when he discovered Edward Jones Investments. Upon retirement he was hired as an investment adviser and took advantage of an opportunity to start an office in San Diego. Some 28 years later, having traded in an F-14 Tomcat Fighter for a desk, Brian truly enjoys his second career in financial planning.
