



So You Think You've Got Talent San Diego is the fundraiser gala for Old Mission Rotary and President Stan Vogelsang reported that the 11th annual talent show generated a net profit of \$28,514.

The Thousand Smiles Foundation received \$21,146 which is about 20% of their annual operating budget.

The Old Mission Rotary Foundation received \$7,369 of the net profits. These funds will be disbursed to a variety of local programs and organizations. We congratulate Michelle Malin who served as the chair of the event.

San Diego Blood Bank

San Diego is truly blessed to have a world class blood bank in our city! Susan Josephson is the Development Manager, of the San Diego Blood Bank and she presented an informative and comprehensive presentation at our meeting on Tuesday, August 22nd.

The San Diego Blood Bank was established in 1950 and today collects over 100,000 pints of blood donations per year from eight regional full service fixed locations and 10 fully equipped mobile units. The San Diego Blood Bank must collect more than 350 units of blood each day to meet the needs of local patients who are battling life-threatening blood disorders and cancers, suffering from traumas such as burns or serious accidents, or even complications from childbirth. One pint of blood can save up to three lives.

UPENDO One Kid at a Time



Our speaker on Tuesday, August 15th was Kathleen T. Harris, Ph.D., J.D.. She is an educator and international traveller and coordinates fundraising for the Upendo Foundation in Tanzania.

The Swahili word for love is Upendo and the UPENDO - One Kid at a Time project was created in 2015 to provide sustainable support to orphaned children in Tanzania. The orphans in this West African country include children from unstable one parent homes. Many of the children are from a mother who is abandoned by the child's father. Other children arrive at the orphanage straight from the hospital after birth or have been abandoned as infants. Unfortunately, up to now, when the children reach five years of age they have been dispersed and relocated.

The immediate goal is to build a new center which will be the permanent home for the children who are five-years old and older. The new facility will hold self-contained quarters, an infirmary, open-air dining room, kitchen and storage, recreational rooms, class-rooms, a service learning building, administrative offices, a residence for care-takers and intramural fields. Future plans include a farm that would provide the center with most of its staple foods including cereals, vegetables and fruits.

The San Diego Blood Bank provides Southern California regional hospitals with a wide range of blood banking services. These include blood collection, component preparation, plateletpheresis, plasmapheresis, leukapheresis, washed blood, frozen blood, autologous storage, designated donation services, and a reference laboratory. San Diego Blood Bank's Cord Blood Banking Program provides lifesaving stem cell transplants to patients worldwide.
