The Medical Minute



Dr. Kevin Glynn finished his career as the Medical Director of Respiratory Care at Mercy Hospital.

JAMA this week contained one article and two editorials about ecigarettes. They point out this is a growing market, expected to reach \$10 billion by 2017. The World Health Organization has called for restrictions on advertisements for e-nicotine devices, especially those targeting young people. Supporters of e-nicotine devices claim they help in smoking cessation, but the evidence does not suggest they are superior to nicotine patches and gum. In addition, manufacturers aim to entice young people by flavoring nicotine cartridges with candy, fruit, and cola. Furthermore, the propellants in e-cigarettes generate compounds that degrade to formaldehyde, a potential carcinogen, when aerosolized. Finally, nicotine in any form is extremely addicting. Tobacco manufacturers are switching to e-cigarettes as conventional cigarettes decline in sales, and are lobbying to promote the products globally. China alone has 300 million smokers

E-cigarettes may have a role in the future for smoking cessation, but evidence is scanty and potential harms are great.
