## **Come Fly Away**

Our ZOOM Club program on August 25th was presented by Michelle Brega, Senior Director, External Relations, San Diego Regional Airport Authority When Terminal 1 at the San .Diego International Airport first opened in 1967, it served 2.5 million passengers in its first year. Today, the same facility serves more than 12 million. For roughly half of our visitors, Terminal 1 provides their first impression of San Diego. Admittedly, it's not a very good one. The Airport Development Plan (ADP) envisions the replacement of Terminal 1 with a more modern facility and other improvements that enhance the airport experience for everyone.

Construction will start on the new terminal project in 2021 and it is scheduled to open in 2024.
