Voting in San Diego

Our speaker on October 13th was Rosie Rascon who is a Voter Outreach Coordinator with the San Diego Registrar of Voters Office. She joined us to talk about the work underway to make sure this year's General Election is safe and secure for all registered voters.

Rosie Rascon will presented a program on the mechanics and procedures in place to protect each vote. She discussed the built-in layers of protection in the process, from the polls to the secure tabulation building and then on to the California Secretary of State. In addition to offering traditional in-person voting, Governor Newsom has ordered mail-in ballots to be sent to all registered voters.

She also covered the changes in place this election cycle due to the coronavirus.:

October 19th is the last day to Register yo Vote and Election Day is November 3rd. The polls will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Mail in ballots must be postmarked on election day. Rosie stressed that the registrar and post office are well prepared for all of the mail in ballots expected.
