Corona Conversation



At today's Corona Conversation, club member Don Krupp talked about the processes underway for the development of a vaccine for COVID-19. He talked about how Operation Warp Speed is intended to accelerate both the testing and manufacturing of an effective vaccine without sacrificing safety. We learned that six pharmaceutical companies have received federal funds for their research and production capacity and that, worldwide, there are 150 companies working to develop a vaccine. Once a safe and effective vaccine has been fully tested and licensed. the next challenge will be producing and distributing sufficient quantities so enough people can be vaccinated to achieve herd immunity in the United States. Don predicted that may take as much as a year for that critical threshold to be reached. In the meantime, we should all be prepared to continue wearing masks in public places and practicing physical distances to curtail the spread of the disease.
