Community Campership Council



Susan Thorning presented a program on the Community Campership Council on November 11.

The Community Campership Council, Inc., is a charitable organization established in 1966 to coordinate a year-round "Kids to Camp" Campership Program. The Goal of their Kids to Camp Program is to make available a joyful learning experience in a natural setting for deserving children from diverse backgrounds. They strive to promote understanding of nature and the environment and the importance of conservation. A major goal is to give hope to and build confidence among in under privileged youth.

Camps that the kids attend range from programs by the Boy and Girl Scouts, YMCAs and churches.

- 70% of the campers come from families that are below the poverty line.

- 88% qualify for free lunch programs at school,

- 36% are Latino and 13% are African American

The heaviest concentration of camperships comes from the central city area. The average cost of a campership is \$143.

It is hard to describe what it means to a child to experience the wonders of camp.
