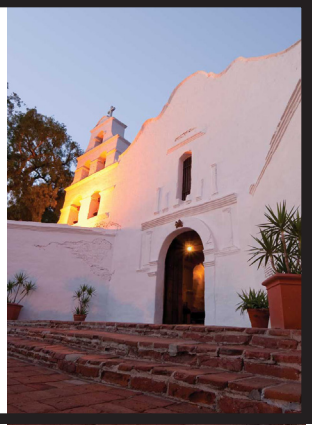

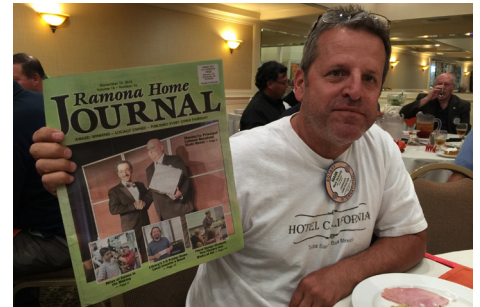
The mission of San Diego Youth Services is to help at-risk youth and their families become self-sufficient and reach their highest potential. San Diego Youth Services (SDYS) is a nationally recognized non-profit organization that since founded, has helped to improve the lives of hundreds of thousands of homeless, runaway, abused and at-risk youth and their families. Launched in 1970, when volunteers established one of the first runaway youth shelters in America, SDYS now provides intensive services to more than 20,000 children and their families each year. This nationally recognized agency offers emergency services, safe places to live and long-term solutions for kids "on their own" by providing shelters, group homes, foster homes, community centers and transitional housing. Professional help for high risk youth is provided at all 14 major locations in San Diego County.

The Art Pratt Foundation of Old Mission Rotary presented a grant to SDYS for \$10,000 on November 17th.

On November 24th, Tom Goodwin talked about his life and his career at the San Diego Unified School District.

Tom Goodwin has lived a fascinating life! He grew up in the rough logging and fishing Oregon Coast and eventually discovered a passion for teaching and education.

Tom rose to the position of Superintendent of the San Diego Unified School District. During his tenure, the district faces a number of challenges including desegregation and earthquake safety. He introduced the Mastery Learning which is a method of instruction where the focus is on the role of feedback in learning. Tom also managed the closing of many inner city schools and the construction of 28 schools in the suburbs.
