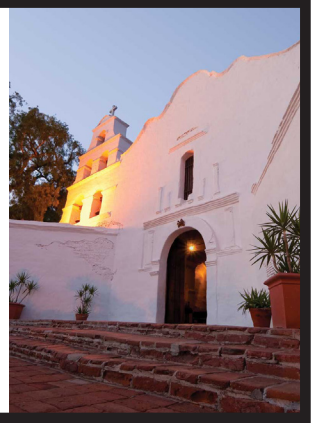

Shari Stauder is a new member of Old Mission Rotary.

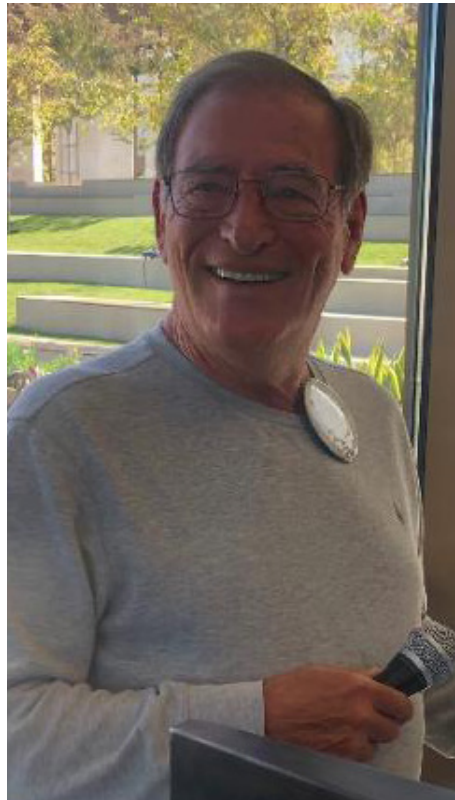
