Charter Schools

Our speaker on December 16 was our very own Old Mission Rotarian Miles Durfee. Miles is the Managing Regional Director for Southern California of the California Charter School Association.

Miles manages the team responsible for charter school policy in San Diego, San Bernardino, Riverside, Orange and Imperial Counties. Additionally, he leads the information and advocacy program in San Diego County with nearly 100 charter schools in the County and over 40 authorized by San Diego Unified School District.

California has the highest number of charter schools of any state in the country with 1,130 schools serving over 500,000 students. Parents, educators and community members decide to start charter schools for a variety of reasons. Some start schools to address the needs of an under-served population, to create a new option in their community that serves students differently, or to innovate and find new ways of educating students that will forever change the way they learn. Charter schools are public schools. They are tuitionfree and open to any student who wishes to attend. Charter schools allow parents, organizations, or community groups to restore, reinvent, and reenergize our public school system. Charter schools are designed, tailored, and governed by each local community, rather than by a central bureaucracy. Charter schools are open to all children and they are committed to serving a student body that reflects the local community. Research evidence shows that charter school students are just as diverse (racially and economically) as non-charter students.
