As a young Marine, Isaac was severely wounded in Afghanistan. After years of struggle Isaac has inspired us at Old Mission Rotary with his attitude and achievements. He even climbed the tallest mountain in Australia. Mount Kosciuszko, in a driving snowstorm with the Heroes Project. We also remember the Wounded Warriors we have met that still struggle and in one case committed suicide.

Old Mission Rotary is thrilled for Isaac and his new home. He is a member of the Old Mission Rotary family and we will always be available to help him!
