Catholic Charities Homeless Women



Michele Tondreau of Catholic Charities presented a very important program on homeless women.

Michelle Tondreau of Catholic Charities was our speaker on February 3rd. Catholic Charities provides a multi-faceted array of programs for the community. In 1980, the non profit opened Rachel's Homeless Women's Walk-in Day Center as the first transitional residence for homeless women in San Diego County. Rachel's provides day and night shelter for women and their children, as well as transitional housing for women over age 50 and pregnant women. Services include work readiness, medical, substance recovery, clothing, laundry, showers, counseling, parenting classes, transportation and more. Michelle also introduced us to The Tomorrow Project. This Catholic Charities program provides work readiness training for homeless women. The social entrepreneurial program was developed in 1994 to give homeless women worthwhile work and to provide them opportunities to change or to improve their circumstances, and to earn a small stipend.

At The Tomorrow Project, homeless women have the opportunity to learn work skills while creating gourmet food products and selling them in the community.



The Art Pratt Foundation of Old Mission Rotary awarded Reality Changers with a grant for \$13,608. Reality Changers transforms lives, schools, and communities by providing youth from disadvantaged backgrounds with the academic support, financial assistance and leadership training to become first generation college students. The funds will be used for tables, chairs and digital tablets for the Reality Changer's 1004 square foot study room that serves over 500 students per week. The presentation was made before five Reality Changer students participated in the Old Mission Four Way test Speech contest during on February 10th.
