## → GOODWILL

Students empowered to study first hand some of the problems and accomplishments of people in lands other than their own.

## → AMBASSADORS

Students act as ambassadors for their own country by addressing Rotary clubs, community organizations and youth groups in their host country.

## → BROADEN OUTLOOK

Students live with and meet people of different cultures, creeds, and colors and develop skills to cope with day-to-day challenges in a new environment.

Students advance their education by studying for a year in an environment entirely different from their own, and taking courses and subjects not normally available to them in their own country.
