

Last Week's Program

Joe Dominey gave his classification talk and discussed the district's RI Public Image Grant.

Joe's classification is Public Relations and Advertising and he ioined rotary in 1985 at the Downtown Club in Midland and is now a Paul Harris Fellow. His father served in WWII as a flight surgeon and retired as captain in Navy Medical Corp. During Joe's childhood they lived in many places in the world. He earned his BA in 1962 at the University of Texas in Fine Arts in Radio and Television. While at Texas he worked part time at the radio station KVET in Austin. After graduation he worked in many other radio and TV stations San Angelo and Midland, and then worked in public relations at the Midland National Bank. After banking, Joe worked in advertising and then founded his own advertising business, Dominey & Etheridge, running ads in Midland and Odessa. He left that company and retired in 2009 before his wife died 2010. He served on many boards in Midland. Joe remarried in 2012 and moved to Lubbock. After his classification talk, Joe discussed the public image for district grants in the 51 clubs for Rotary district 5730, which is a spread out district as large as the state of Illinois. He started in 2010 and helped get public image and matching grants the three largest markets Amarillo, Lubbock and Midland-Odessa. Public image grants are for \$15,000 plus matching grants for TV and newspaper advertising to attract Rotary members.
