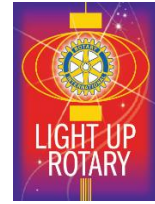



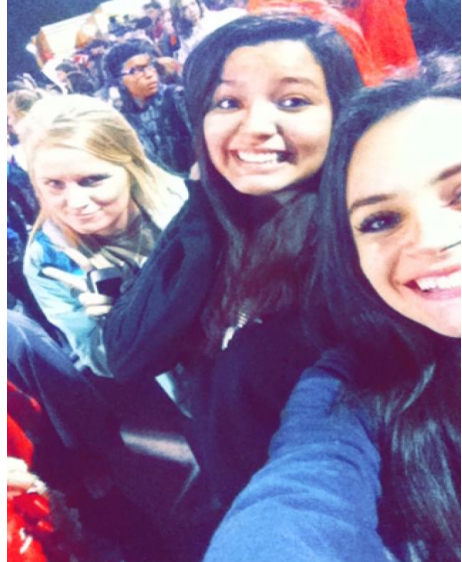

Tommy Jones, who was a sheriff in Crane and now, investigates fraud cases at Texas Mutual Insurance Company, the leading provider of workers' comp insurance in Texas. He told us fraud in insurance is a big problem and costs companies a lot of money. We learned what is and how difficult it is for insurance companies to win cases against claimants. He showed us videos of fraud situations where claims had been filed on his insurance company and the injured were shown active and perfectly healthy. He looks for a lies and if he can discover a lie he can file against the claimant. He showed us cameras in a pen holder and car keys they use to discover frauds. We learned and saw films about many cases he has investigated where the injured were just fine.
