- **What is "Student of the Month"?** The Rotary Club of Plainview seeks to recognize high school seniors for service to their community and fellow man.
- **How can a student be nominated?** *Anyone may nominate a student for this award.* The application must be completed in full and returned by the deadline. The program is open to all public school, private school, and home school students that live in Hale County (they may attend elsewhere).
- **How are students recognized?** Selected students participate in Rotary meetings for one month. Three meetings are Tuesday lunches and one is an evening social or service project.
- **If a student does not win, can he/she be nominated again?** Yes. All students not chosen in a particular month will be reconsidered for the award the next month, along with any new nominees. You will not have to resubmit your nomination.
- **What is the Student of the Month scholarship?** At the end of the school year, Students of the Month receive a \$250 college scholarship.
