



Safety Officer Rotary District 5180

Bill Van Duker introduced our Guest Speaker, Gary Kalar, District 5180 Safety Officer... Gary spoke to us about Youth Protection, explaining that Rotary takes protection of our youth very seriously...He spoke about the do's and don'ts about protection and the requirements becoming more and more stringent. He addressed periodic clearances and explained the three different levels...#1 being the lowest level, #2 Level as an example, would be Rotarians mentoring interact clubs, etc and #3 as the highest level, example, host family... The idea behind this is to be prepared for a planned interaction by having that person screened...Unplanned interaction is best explained as using the 2 on 1 Rule, either 2 adults and 1 kid or 2 kids and 1 adult... Barry made himself available after the meeting for those of us that require the additional levels to complete the required paperwork...**Thanks Barry, for giving us the opportunity to continue to make a difference in our community by working with the youth...**


OBJECT OF ROTARY

History of the Rotary Foundation

At the 1917 convention, outgoing RI President Arch C. Klumph proposed to set up an endowment "for the purpose of doing good in the world." In 1928, it was renamed The Rotary Foundation, and it became a distinct entity within Rotary International. In 1929, the Foundation made its first gift of \$500 to the Inter-Society for Crippled Children. The org., created by Rotarian Edgar F. "Daddy" Allen, later grew into Easter Seals. When Rotary founder Paul Harris died in 1947, contributions began pouring in to Rotary International, and the Paul Harris Memorial Fund was created to build the Foundation. 1947: The Foundation established its first program, Fellowships for Advance Study, later known as Ambassadorial Scholarships. 1965-66: Three programs were launched: Group Study Exchange, Awards for Technical Training, and Grants for Activities in Keeping with the Objective of The Rotary Found., which was later called Matching Grants. 1978: Rotary introduced the Health, Hunger and Humanity (3-H) Grants. The first 3-H Grant funded a project to immunize 6 million Philippine children against polio. 1985: The [PolioPlus program](#) was launched to eradicate polio worldwide. 1987-88: The first peace forums were held, leading to [Rotary Peace Fellowships](#). 2013: New [district, global, and packaged grants](#) enable Rotarians around the world to respond to the world's greatest needs. Since the first donation of \$26.50 in 1917, the Foundation has received contributions totaling more than \$1 billion.


