Foundation Impact Report 2025


Join Us! We make lives better



The collective commitment, efforts, and generosity of our members and community make a difference in people's lives locally and internationally. The level of impact from the Elk Grove Rotary Foundation continues to grow. Major club projects over the last several years include distributing dictionaries to 3rd grade students, Project RIDE Sensory Trail, providing Thanksgiving food baskets to families in need, wildfire disaster relief to people in Southern CA, Lahaina and Paradise, supporting Future Farmers of America at County Fair and supporting the homeless through EG HART. On the international stage, Foundation projects include delivering emergency shelter to families displaced by disaster or conflict through ShelterBox USA, packing 10,000 meals for those with food insecurities, supporting education at Iruri Primary School in Kenya, providing clean water in Africa and Honduras, supplying building materials for homes in El Salvador.

The EG Rotary Foundation focuses on 7 areas of impact: Peace and Conflict Resolution; Disease Prevention and Treatment; Water, Sanitation and Hygiene; Maternal and Child Health; Education and Literacy; Community Economic Development; and the Environment. Our vision is to expand in all seven areas of impact.
