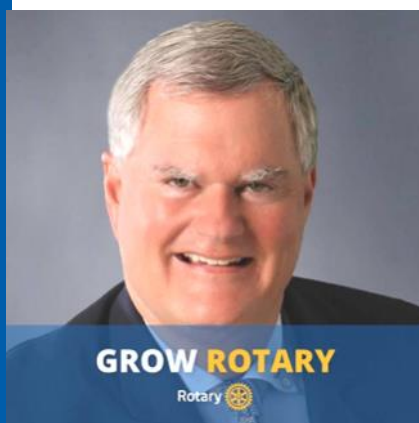


Rotary Opens Opportunities

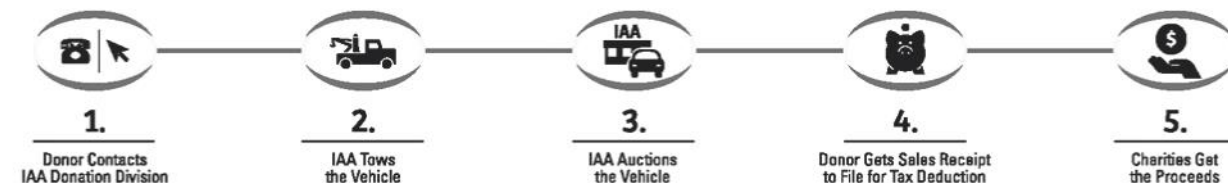
