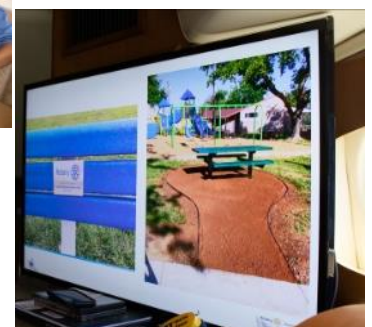
In addition, through education and other district events, we will create an environment that is fun and social so members can increase friendships and vocational opportunities

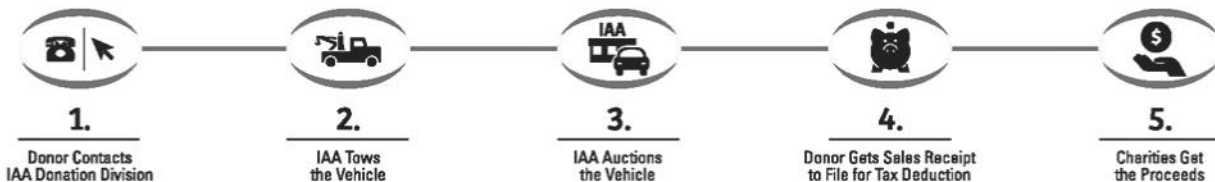
