#### **Letter from Gordon Lipp**

#### "What a Difference a Day Makes ... 24 Little Hours"

If you are a senior or an old-timer, you might recognize these lyrics and remember how true they are.

Our 90-day experience ... or nightmare ... began March 3rd at 1:15 p.m. when **Polly** fell, breaking her hip. It ended June 3rd when we closed escrow on the sale of our home.

This has been 90 days of turmoil, anguish, loneliness, pure exhaustion, and change. More change than you can imagine. And yes, there were some good things that happened along the way.

**Polly** survived major surgery to repair her hip, plus six weeks of medical rehabilitation, (which was more like solitary confinement for her). Our separation was extensive and very difficult.

To make matters worse, on April 8th, (at 4:00 a.m.) I was admitted to the hospital ER for a bladder blockage. This resulted in a cauterization procedure in one of my ureters to control a cancerous growth. Unfortunately, it took two operations to accomplish as the first procedure was aborted due to equipment failure.

I was flat on my back in the hospital for six days.

**Polly** and I both needed full-time help. We could not go home. So, on April 16th, we moved to a temporary apartment at Atria El Camino Gardens. Our new address is:

To accomplish all of these moves and pay for them, it was necessary to sell our home of 60 years. This added a huge load to our 90-day journey of exhaustion. Fortunately, our home sold within five days and \$40,000.00 over asking price. Escrow closed exactly 90 days after **Polly** fell.

Additional challenges that are impossible to describe included selling our car and juggling countless details. During this, our daughter was busy closing her tax practice of 30 years.

How our family made all of this happen I do not know, and I am afraid to ask. Our family spent hundreds of hours keeping this project "on the rails." Daughter **Lorrie** and her husband, **Dave**, and son **Doug** with his wife, **Pam**, did all of the HEAVY LIFTING. Nothing would have happened without their help.

We are blessed beyond belief to have them want to be a part of our lives.

So, there it is. What a Difference a Day Makes ... 24 Little Hours.
