HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

PE Marilee introduced our Sunny Mojonnier. Sunny was former Assembly Member, who represented parts of San Diego County from 1982 through 1990. During her time in office, she authored and had signed into law legislation dealing with important issues such as hazardous medical waste management, closed circuit television testimony for use in the courtroom, and protecting the California coastline.

Capitol In 1983, **Sunny** founded female Network, network for a legislative and administrative professions in Sacramento, and it still is in existence today. At the end of her legislative career, she was appointed to serve on the California Medical Assistance Commission. In 2014, she founded the Women in California Politics Foundation and Museum, which has the largest collection of video recorded oral histories and historical memorabilia on California's women legislators.

Sunny then shared some of the details of what she has done. June 18, 2018 was the Centennial celebration of the 1st 100 years of women being elected to the CA legislature. She has been producing videorecorded oral histories of the women that shaped California politics, these videohistories recorded oral capture the personality, enthusiasm, passion commitment of the women who blazed new trails in our state. You can hear how they


chose which areas they would focus on, what most influenced their decision to run, what types of previous experiences helped/ hindered them, hear about their successes, failures & greatest triumphs. This collection of videos will serve as a valuable tool & resource to empower, educate & inspire present & future generations. This exciting adventure is as fulfilling as it is challenging. We have produced over 20 video-recorded oral histories (some of those interviewed are no longer with us). As a business owner, problem solver & creative thinker I've engaged in management of a variety of business projects, developing policies. writing business plans, evaluation standards, risk assessment, procedures guidelines.

Sunny was the 30th woman elected to CA's Legislature, covering San Diego's 55 miles of coast from the Mexican border north to Carlsbad.
